What is Title I?

Title I is a federally funded grant run through New York State that helps provide services for struggling students in English Language Arts (ELA) and Math in grades K-12.

Students are included in the regular classroom instruction for ELA and Math, just like always. They may receive additional instruction and support in developing ELA and/or Math skills and strategies.

Why your child may be selected for ELA and/or Math support

- **Scoring below level of proficiency on local screening measures**
- **At-risk of not meeting the New York State learning standards**
- **Teacher recommendation**

What is taught and how often will my child receive services?

- **Instruction will reinforce and support what is taught in the classroom based on the student's area of weakness.**
- **The amount of time depends on the needs of the student.**

How parents can help?

- **Talk to your children about what they're learning in school.**
- **Read with your child and practice math facts.**
- **Communicate frequently with the school.**
- **Contact the classroom teacher or Title I teacher if you have questions or concerns.**
