- 10 Tips for Visiting a College Campus-

### \*Due to current circumstances check college websites for specific information\*

Your campus visit experience may be one of the most influential factors in your college selection process. Following are 10 tips for making the most of your experience.

- 1. Always call ahead to ask about visit opportunities, including interviews, classroom or overnight visits and open houses.
- 2. If you're unfamiliar with the area, request a copy of directions to campus.
- 3. Schedule an appointment for an interview. If you'd like to meet with a coach or professor, inform the Admission Office counselors so they can advise you in making those arrangements.
- 4. Dress appropriately but comfortably for your interview.
- 5. Research the college, and be prepared to ask questions of your own during the interview. Remember: You want to find out whether the college is a good fit for you.
- 6. Arrive on time.
- 7. Pick up campus literature during your visit the college newspaper, college catalog or financial aid brochures, for instance.
- 8. Arrange to eat in one of the campus dining halls.
- 9. Take a student-led tour, and then explore the campus on your own. Ask your tour guide and other current students about their experiences.
- 10. Before leaving, take some time to explore the surrounding community
